

Instruction to Authors

The Indian Journal of Perinatology and Reproductive Biology, a multidisciplinary journal, publishes material related to the total health care area of perinatology and reproductive medicine. Manuscripts are considered for publication with the understanding that they have not been published previously and not under consideration by another journal. All manuscripts must be accompanied by the following statement: *"We confirm that the article is original, and is not under consideration by another journal. We sign for and accept responsibility for releasing this article."*

Manuscripts

1. Manuscripts must be submitted in triplicate and along with a CD in microsoft word.
2. Manuscripts should be typed on one side of A4 paper only, be double-spaced and have 2.5 cm margins. Pages should be numbered. The original one good quality copy is required.
3. Each manuscript component should begin on a new page, in this sequence; title page; abstract and key words; text; acknowledgement; references; tables and illustrations; legends for illustrations. In an original article, the text should comprise Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results and Discussion.
4. The first page should contain the title, name(s) of the

author(s) with up to two relevant qualifications and details of their appointments and the name and contact details for correspondence, including e-mail address.

5. The title page should contain(1) the title of the article;(2) first name, middle, initial and last name of each author;(3) name of department(s) of support in the form of grants; and (6) a short running title of no more than 40 characters (count letters and spaces).
6. The second page should carry an abstract.

A structured abstract is required for original research articles, and a standard abstract format is required for other types of articles.

The structured abstract limited to 250 words, is to contain the major headings of: Objective (s); Methods (Study Design); Results; and Conclusion (s).

References

References should be set out in Vancouver style.
