

## **Report of Midterm ISOPARB Conference organized by ISOPARB Ranchi Chapter**

The pleasant weather of Ranchi witnessed the scientific extravaganza in form of midterm ISOPARB conference on 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> Sep, 2019 at Mayuri Hall, Kanke Road, Ranchi. The conference was organized by ISOPARB Ranchi Chapter under the supervision of Dr. Usha Rani (Patron), Dr. Priti Bala Sahay, Dr. Suman Sinha, Dr. Rajesh Kumar (Organising Chairpersons), Dr. Jyoti Roy, Dr. Archana Kumari, Dr. Sunita Jha (Organising Secretaries), Dr. Anjana Jha (Treasurer). The theme of the conference was “PREVENTING THE PREVENTABLES”. The conference was very successful with participation of about 300 delegates and about 50 national faculty coming from four zones of ISOPARB.

First day of scientific session on 14<sup>th</sup> Sep started with session on “Perinatology” with deliberations of eminent pediatricians of Jharkhand. Highlight of the first day of the scientific session was **Late Dr. Raj Kishori Jha Oration** delivered by Dr. Alpesh Gandhi (FOGSI President elect) on topic “Periconceptional Care: Concept relevant to Critical Obst. Care!”. Other highlights were keynote lectures by Dr. Suchitra Pandit (President, ISOPARB) on the topic “Pregnancy post fertility: How do we fare!” and by Dr. Gangadhar Sahoo (Vice President, ISOPARB) on the topic “Obstetrician & Attitude: A Food for thought!”. The eminent national faculty for this day were Dr. S. N. Tripathy, Dr. Manju Gita Mishra, Dr. Milind Shah, Dr. Sudeep Chakraborty, Dr. Shanti H. K. Singh, Dr. Mala Shrivastav. A panel discussion on “Adolescent Gynaec Problem” was moderated by Dr. Meena Samant (Secretary General ISOPARB) and Dr. Rooma Sinha.

A unique feature was the timing of **“Inaugural function” between 11.30 AM to 12.30PM** instead of the traditional evening inauguration. The idea behind this timing was to have a houseful audience. The conference was inaugurated by Dr. Nitin Madan Kulkarni, Secretary, Health & Family Welfare as the chief guest and Prof. Dr. D. K. Singh, Director, RIMS as the guest of honor. Dr. Suchitra Pandit gave the presidential address, Dr. Meena Samant presented the secretary general report, Dr. Suma Sinha welcomed the guests and Dr. Archana Kumari proposed the vote of thanks. Executive body meeting of ISOPARB was held between 4.30PM-5.30 PM. Another unique feature of this conference was a **Rally for “Violence against Doctors”** in which senior as well as junior Gynecologists and Obstetricians walked with posters in hand to create awareness among the public. The idea of organising the rally was the vision of Dr. Suchitra Pandit. Other First day of the conference ended with beautiful cultural programme by medical students of RIMS and Gala dinner.

Second day of the conference started with session of “Free paper of PGs” with participations of 8 Post graduates. The Hiralal Konar, Dr. Narayan Jana and Dr. P. B. Sahay were judges for this session. Dr. Tanu Sharma (JR-III) RIMS was awarded first prize and Dr. Dipika Deepak was awarded second prize, Dr. Ankita Ratan, Dr. Smriti, Dr. Aishwarya, Dr. Manisha Kumari and Dr. Shivangi were the participants. The highlights of second day was keynote lecture on “Disorders of sexual differentiation: A real challenge” presented by Dr. Arup Kumar Majhi (Vice

President ISOPARB). A panel discussion on “Obstetrics Emergencies: Preventing Maternal Deaths” was moderated by Dr. Parul Kotdawala and Dr. Achana Kumari. Another panel discussion on “Endoscopy in Infertility: Case based discussion” moderated by Dr. Pragya Mishra (Treasurer ISOPARB) was an instant hit with participation of eminent panelists like Dr. G. D. Sahoo, Dr, Sukumar Barik, Dr. S. K. Jena, Dr. Aha Rani Sinha, Dr. Ram Prasad Dey volunteering on the spot, in the event of pre planned panelist not turning up on the day. Eminent speakers for the scientific session on second day were Dr. Tapasi Pati, Dr. Hemali Heidi Sinha, Dr. Usha Sharma, Dr. Madhumati, Dr. Hiralal Konar & Dr. Rajiv Rathi. The heated debate on “IInd stage delay: Instrumental Vs Cesarean Section” with Dr. Amita Sinha speaking for Cesarean Section and Dr. Nivedita Dutta speaking for Instrumental Delivery was applauded by the audience. The valedictory session witnessed the auspicious presence of ISOPARB Vice presidents Dr. Arup Kumar Majhi, Dr. G. D. Sahoo, Dr. Narayan Jana along with senior Isoparbian Dr. Sukumar Barik.
